### YOUR GIVING AT WORK Grantees making a difference

Gates Philanthropy Partners made its first grant from the Combating COVID-19 Fund to support the development of an easy to use, rapid-results diagnostic test for use in Africa. We have since deployed 17 additional grants to expand and accelerate vetted Gates Foundation projects and support grantee partners. Together, we are supporting a range of organizations—from researchers in labs who are working at unprecedented speed to understand this virus and disease, to frontline workers who are risking their own health and safety to care for the most vulnerable.

### 100 DAYS FROM 1 CASE TO 1 MILLION A global crisis unfolds...

On January 12, scientists in China shared the genetic sequence for the novel coronavirus, allowing scientists and clinicians around the world to quickly get to work to understand more about the virus and COVID-19 disease. Just 10 weeks later, the World Health Organization officially declared a pandemic on March 11.

By April, as we were making our first COVID-19 related grants, 1 million cases had been confirmed globally. It will take a combination of tools to help prevent, diagnose, and treat COVID-19. And, those tools will need to be quickly produced and distributed to billions of people—a challenge the world has never faced.


